Celebrating the 50th anniversary of John Brook's classic book — *A Long the Riverrun*



Return to Riverrun is a portfolio of six luminous pictures from Brook's book reproduced in superbly crafted giclée prints, accompanied by texts setting Brook's work in context.

The giclée prints were printed by Gary Samson on Red River Palo Duro SoftGloss Rag. The portfolio box and layout were designed by Jim Fitts. The biography and portfolio introduction were written by Jessica Roscio, Director and Curator of the Danforth Museum of Art. The text is printed on Moab Entrada Rag Bright 300.

The portfolio is limited to an edition of twelve, plus two archive copies. The price is \$900.00 through February 28, 2021, and \$1,100.00 thereafter.

Return to Riverrun is dedicated to the memory of Robert W. Rogers, who advocated that Brook's photographic legacy be preserved and promoted. Proceeds from portfolio sales support the work of the John Brook Archive.

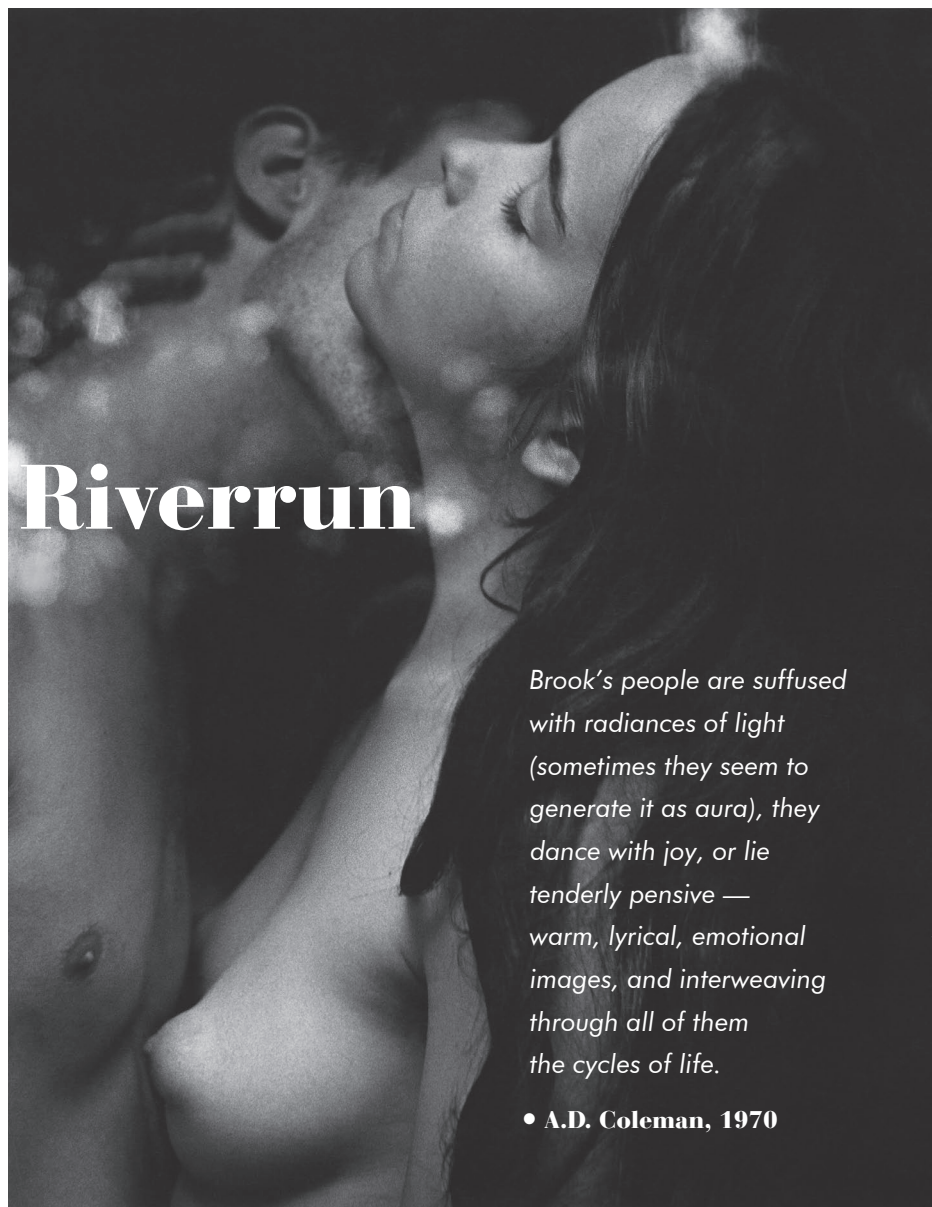

Return to Riverrun

In 1970, John Brook published *A Long the Riverrun*—a panegyric to loving human relationships in forty-six photographs. Long out of print, the book is now a valued collector's item.

Return to Riverrun makes six of Brook's luminous pictures from the book available in superbly crafted giclée prints, accompanied by texts setting the work of the wonderfully eccentric photographer in context.

The portfolio is published in conjunction with an exhibition at the Griffin Museum of Photography—the first major exhibition of Brook's work since the 1970s.



Brook's people are suffused with radiances of light (sometimes they seem to generate it as aura), they dance with joy, or lie tenderly pensive — warm, lyrical, emotional images, and interweaving through all of them the cycles of life.
